SCHOOL PROFILE

Kitchener Road Primary School is a large multicultural school in the Riverside are of Cardiff. The school community is one that is fluid, rich, vibrant and diverse, and their vision for the school is one in which 'new and exciting things' happen.

KEY QUESTION

Can using a creative approach to teaching Maths, and in particular the integrated use of Stop Motion animation, have an impact on the attainment levels of year 4 and year 6 pupils?

LEARNER PROFILE

The project will involve a class of mixed ability Year 4 pupils and a class of mixed ability Year 6 pupils.

PROPOSED SCHEDULE

All practitioners must attend the Lead Creative Schools Scheme training on 12th and 13th January 2015. This will take place in a venue in the Cardiff area.

The project will begin in the week beginning of the 18th January and will take place across the remainder of the Spring school term, consisting of weekly sessions with each participating class. Although animation will form the foundation for the creative learning, we are anticipating that other practitioners with a drama, music, dance and singing skillset will also work on the project at various points.

The staff would like to aim towards a final product or outcome that would be shared with parents and the wider community.

FEE STRUCTURE

Across the Lead Creative School Scheme there is a fixed daily rate for practitioners of £250 per day. This is inclusive of travel and subsistence.
