Dahl-icious smells hit the big screen

SMELLOVISION is coming to Bristol with a scented screening of children's classic *Matilda*.

As part of <u>Roald Dahl on Film</u> season, Scratch in Smill Cinema is bringing the screening to Bristol's Watershed this weekend.

Fans of the family favourite, released in 1996, featuring Danny De-Vito and Pam Ferris, can almost taste Bruce Bogtrotter's giant chocolate cake and wrinkle their noses at the stink of fish paste sandwiches. Audiences will be given a special scratch card holding ten scents. They will then be prompted to break the seal on each one at key scenes in the film. Sources of the smells are named on the card, but not the actual scent, meaning viewers will have to guess and compare notes with friends.

A spokesperson explains: "Our techniques are deliberately silly and old-fashioned, using placards, a torch and scent-soaked scratch cards. We think Roald Dahl would approve of our acting daft in a space where we're supposed to behave."

Screenings take place at 2.40pm on Saturday and Sunday. Tickets cost £6.50 for adults and £4.50 concessions, children and under 24s.
